Houston, TX – The Astrodome Conservancy today announced the release of a Request for Information (RFI) inviting interested parties to provide ideas, feedback, and potential development concepts for the future of the historic Astrodome.

The RFI marks an important step in advancing efforts to explore innovative, market-informed strategies to revitalize the iconic venue. Through this process, the Conservancy is seeking input from developers, investors, operators, and other stakeholders with experience in large-scale, mixed-use, and adaptive reuse projects.

“This RFI is an opportunity for the market to help shape a shared vision for the Astrodome,” said Beth Wiedower Jackson, Executive Director of the Astrodome Conservancy. “We are looking to gather creative, feasible, and financially viable ideas that reflect both the significance of the Astrodome and its potential as a catalyst for future development.”

Interested parties are encouraged to submit responses outlining potential concepts, partnership structures, financing approaches, and implementation strategies. Feedback provided through the RFI will inform the Conservancy's next steps.

The Astrodome, a State of Texas Antiquities Landmark, included in the National Register of Historic Places, and Houston's most recognizable icon, was recently named one of Time Magazine's Top 25 Buildings and Monuments that represent America. The Astrodome presents a unique opportunity for adaptive reuse and redevelopment that honors its legacy while positioning it for long-term community and economic impact.
